Swiss champion: 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001, 2004, 2006, 2015 + vice-champion 2002 and 2003.

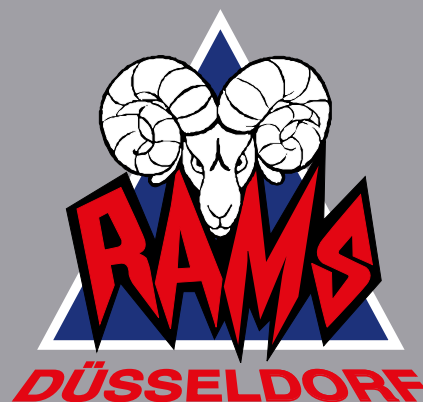

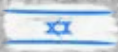


Copenhagen Vikings dates back to 1987 and is the oldest and one of the most successful skater hockey clubs in Denmark with many national as well as international titles to its credit.
